
About the 5G Installation

Morton Feldman (1926-1987)

Written two years before his death in 1987, Morton Feldman's Piano and String Quartet is a shimmering, pristine musical event. Contrasting widely-spaced piano arpeggios with extended string chords, Feldman allows lingering sounds from either the piano or the strings to haze over many of the piece's near-silences. Running time is approximately 80 minutes.
